2. **Name of the scheme : Setting up of Quality Control Laboratory.**
3. **Objectives :** To ensure complaints with National Food Standards. To assist industries in the food sector to develop and implement quality management systems such as ISO-9000, HACCP etc. To analyse the samples received from food processing industries, and other stakeholders. To impart training in the areas relating to quality improvement through own expertise. To provide on information on quality standards and requirements of various markets on quality of products. To reduce the time of analysis of samples by reducing transportation time of samples.

Good quality foods are highly essential for keeping good health of the people. So the production of quality controlled food products are highly required by the Food Processing Industries sectors. For testing and keeping the qualities of food products, the setting up of Quality Control Laboratory is badly required in the Food Processing Training Centre, Porompat, Imphal East. Funding will be grant-in-aid basis, 75% Central and 25% State. The Project Cost proposed is Rs.80.00 lakh of which 60.00 is to be borne by the centre as 75% Central assistance.
