- 4. **Objectives:** The objective of the scheme is to motivate the food processing industries for adoption of food safety and quality assurance mechanisms such as Total Quality Management (TQM) including ISO-9000, ISO-14000, Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP). To prepare them to face the global completion in International trade in post WTO. To enable adherence to astringent quality in hygiene norms. To enhance product acceptance by overseas buyers. To keep Indian industry technologically abreast of international best practices.

Quality is the main concerned of all processed Food Products and it is also concerned with health. Therefore, total management and assurance are to be adopted by all food processing units and awareness to the general public about the quality of food products are to be given. The total quality management such as ISO - 9000, ISO-1400, Hazard analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP), Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP), Good Hygienic Practices (GHP) etc. This will help the FPI units to complete the National and International markets.

The Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India, is providing assistance to the tune of 75% of the project cost whereas the State share contribution is 25%. It is proposed to implement one Total Quality Management system in Manipur with a project cost of Rs.20.00 lakh in which the state share required is Rs.5.00 lakh. The project is to be implemented at FPTC, Porompat, Imphal East. The total state share for total Quality Control Management is Rs.5.00 lakh for 2006-07.
