2. Name of the scheme: Training on Food Processing Industries.

3. Objectives: To achieve the goal of production target of the country in Agro-Horticultural products, it is highly required to give training to the entrepreneurs of the state. Further, some of the staff in the District Industries Centre in 9(nine) DICs are essential to train in the Food Processing Industries so as to enable to give training and awareness to the entrepreneurs & public who are concerned with food processing Industries. It is therefore, to conduct training on Food Processing Industries in all 9(nine) districts of Manipur and to the entrepreneurs in the district. The total project cost required is Rs.9.00 lakh. So the amount required is Rs.4.75 lakh during 2006-07 as 50% state share. The maximum number of intake capacity of trainees is 30 entrepreneurs each. The number of staff to be trained in Food Processing Industries will be 30 from the Directorate and District offices.

Regular training programme in the field of food processing, quality control, packaging and management, etc. are conducted at CFTRI and other institutions in order to impart knowledge/skill to the entrepreneurs/workers. Training is essential for growth and development of Food Processing Industries and production of standard food products. Training on FPI at FPTC will also be conducted regularly.
